Living with an aggressive dog

If your dog is aggressive around food or bones, feed him on his own in a different room.

Keep aggressive dogs away from children even if they have never bitten anyone before.

Have there been any recent changes in your pet's environment, which may have triggered his aggression, such as a new baby or is the dog left for long periods on his own?

Give your dog more exercise, it's a good outlet for pent up emotions and will help to keep your pet healthy and fit. But keep your dog on a lead and consider investing in a muzzle if necessary until you can discover the reason for his aggression.

Many behavioral problems can be related to an inadequate diet.

As a last resort, neutering your male dog may help to control aggressive behavior.

Anal Glands Disease

In modern-day dogs, [anal glands](#) can often cause health problems. Sometimes the anal gland secretions are not released naturally and build up - leading to thickening of the secretion, clogging of the duct and sometimes even disease, infection and abscesses.

You may have seen your pet with his tail up, dragging his behind across the floor. This is an attempt to relieve the pressure and discomfort of impacted anal glands and is called scooting. Scooting can cause damage to the anus and indicates that your pet is having trouble with his anal glands and needs some type of intervention.

The dog's [anal glands](#) are found just below and either side of the anus. Dog's use the anal glands for marking their territory and leaving their unique smell. Normally, when a dog defecates, the pressure on the anal glands is enough to empty the sacs. A high fiber diet that produces a firm stool will help empty the dog anal glands naturally.

Arthritis

[Arthritis in dogs](#) is a major health problem. In fact, one-fifth of dogs in the US, above the age of seven, suffer from painful DJD (degenerative joint disease) as veterinarians like to say. It is also one of the top recurring pains in dogs that they treat.

Arthritis in dogs can affect their spine, elbows, shoulders, hip and neck. If you're not sure if your dog has arthritis, here are a few obvious signs:

Is he liable to favor one side over another (His joints could be too painful on one side, so he will tend to put more weight on the other to escape pain. He may even show discomfort while standing or even sitting on a specific side)

Unusual weight gain (Because of the painful joints, he may tend to be more lethargic or even sleep more not getting the exercise a fit dog would usually get)

Not as active (If you've noticed he isn't as spirited or unusually hesitant in his movements. This is due to stiff joints). All these symptoms can point to arthritis.

If you've noticed your dog with any one of the above

symptoms for more than a week, don't hesitate to get him to a veterinarian. This way he can be properly diagnosed and treated. There are home remedies that you may even wish to try that will ease the pain of arthritis in dogs.

Diet

Your dog's diet is one area that you might need to look into. Dry dog food is made up mostly of grains which cause inflammation of the joints. A better choice would be to try preparing his meals with raw or cooked meat as well as cooked vegetables.

They are not only healthier for him but should help alleviate some of the swelling in his joints, that's caused by arthritis in dogs. (Stay away from anything spicy such as peppers and even onions). Omega 3 fatty acids can be used as a supplement in order to decrease the amount of inflammation in the joints. Try giving him fish capsules.

Flax seed is also a great anti-inflammatory and can be helpful for arthritis in dogs.

Exercise

Even though your dog may be in pain, it's still significant that he gets a short amount of exercise. If he's not skittish to water, try having him swim. For smaller dogs, a kiddie pool would work great. This way, there is no pressure on the

joints, yet he is still being mobile. Also take him for short 15 minute walks. Don't expect too much from him such as running after a ball or jumping.

Warm and Comfortable rest area

Provide a soft, comfortable area for your dog to sleep. In the winter time, when the cool air can stiffen joints, try putting an old sleeping bag or pillow on the floor to help keep his joints warm. If your dog is an exterior dog, you may want to fetch him into the garage at night to avoid the cold temperatures.

Cancer

Apart from the fact that there are certain carcinogens that cause cancer, very little is known about what causes cancer. In recent years, there has been a significant increase in the incidence of cancer in dogs causing a lot of concern to pet owners.

It has been proven that there is a high probability of some cancer cells present in a body at any given time. A perfectly conditioned and healthy body does not let cancer cells take root. It is the immune system of the body that inhibits these cancer-causing cells from multiplying.

When the body is unhealthy, the immune system triggers certain changes in the body to fight back. When cancer takes hold, the immune system causes certain symptoms to appear in the body. These symptoms are basically the body's mechanism to fight back in order to self-heal.

As the cancer progresses, the self-healing process can go awry. The body cannot handle the constant battle. With the changing priorities of the body system, the normal growth processes are compromised. A diet that can strike a balance between attending to the cancer and the routine growth processes can be of great help in prolonging the life of a dog.

Your dog's body requires a typical diet that is compatible to his structure and needs. It should be kept in mind that human food is not always good for the dog. Further, cancer in dogs requires specific nutrition that can allow them to fight back the disease and continue the other regular body functions.

It is too optimistic to believe that a diet can help in treating cancer in dogs but a certain combination of nutrients can help in preventing cancer. It can also ensure a good quality of life if cancer has already set in.

Not much research has been conducted to understand how diets can manage or prevent cancer in dogs. Whatever research is available suggests that a diet that provides the following substances in sufficient quantities can be of help:

Vitamins C, D and E along with beta carotene and chemical compound of Vitamin A known as retinoids.

Minerals like selenium, copper, zinc, magnesium, calcium, lead, iron, potassium, sodium, iodine and germanium.

Enzymes that help in immunization against cancer causing pathogens - These are available as oral preparations. Garlic has shown excellent results in fighting cancer in experiments performed on rodents.

Green and black tea – believed to have cancer inhibiting properties and can be introduced in the dog meal .

Treatments and surgery for [cancer in dogs](#) can drain the energy out of a dog. If the energy levels dip to extremely low levels, a condition known as cancer cachexia occurs. One of the symptoms of liver cancer in dogs is a loss of appetite and extreme weight loss. Managing the amount of energy spent and supplementing with a healthy diet are the best ways of countering the condition.

Cushing's Disease

[Cushings disease in dogs](#) is a glandular disorder caused by excessive corticosteroids. The process of the production of these corticosteroids is such that:

The pituitary gland produces a hormone called ACTH
The ACTH stimulates the adrenal glands
The adrenal gland produces corticosteroids

A more than required amount of corticosteroid can cause Cushing's disease, so it is also called hyperadrenocorticism (hyper-adreno-corticism).

The overproduction of corticosteroids which causes Cushing's disease in dogs can occur due to two types of conditions. In 85% of the cases, the excessive production of ACTH is caused by a tumor in the pituitary gland that produces high levels of ACTH. This causes the adrenal glands to make more than required levels of corticosteroids.

Hyperadrenocorticism in a dog can also be caused by a corticosteroid-producing tumor in one or both of the adrenal glands.

[Cushing's disease in dogs](#) can also be caused by large doses of synthetic corticosteroids. These steroids may be administered for treating another ailment but in turn produce a side effect that results in Cushing's disease. Cushing's disease generally occurs in dogs that are five years or older. It is more common in female dogs than in male dogs. Some breeds like Terriers, Poodles, and Dachshunds are more prone to Cushing's disease for some inexplicable reason.

Cushing's disease affects the overall health of the dog, since corticosteroids play an important role in a large number of body functions.

Some of the symptoms of the disease are:

A gradual but definite weakening of the ligaments

Weight gain and a potbelly

Degeneration of the skin leading to rashes and lumps

Hair loss

An increase in appetite

High levels of liquid intake

Higher frequency of urination

A gradual degeneration of the nervous system

A series of tests need to be conducted to confirm the presence of Cushings disease in dogs. Samples of blood and diluted urine are analyzed to give a preliminary indication. If the disease is suspected, further laboratory tests are performed that can be fairly accurate in diagnosis and can even direct the physician to the root of the problem.

Some symptoms are, frequent drinking and urinating, weight loss, lack of energy and urinary tract infections. A simple blood test will determine the levels of sugar in your dog.

Obesity, an unhealthy diet and stress can all cause diabetes in dogs.

What else can I do to help my diabetic dog?

Regular daily exercise is essential to help keep your pet healthy, fit and at his ideal weight.

Ensure your pet is eating a balanced high quality diet with plenty of raw and unprocessed food.

Routine is very important with diabetes, so ensure your pet's meals are always at the same time every day.

Several small meals rather than one big one may help with blood sugar control.

Avoid commercially prepared dog foods which may contain high amounts of sugar and preservatives.

Ears

There are many long term benefits related to the timely and proper cleaning of your dog's ears. It helps in maintaining good overall health. If your dog is healthy, it impacts on the general behavior and demeanor of your pet, and he is likely to be more calm and friendly.

Therefore, dog ear grooming goes a long way in your relationship with your dog. It is one aspect of a dog's hygiene that cannot be ignored. An unhealthy dog ear is responsible for more medical conditions than one can imagine. Chronic ear problems can occur due to various allergies or [ear mites](#).

An excess of thyroid hormones can make the condition worse. Using the wrong product to get rid of the dog ear mites can also lead to complications.

Before the start of any treatment for ear infection, the dog's ears should be cleaned in order to get a proper diagnosis. Vinegar diluted in water has been used for this purpose for a long time as part of home remedies for dog ear mites. This solution is good for cleaning purposes and also has curative properties.

Before prescribing any conventional medicine, the veterinarian is likely to want to do a microscopic examination of the wax extracted with the help of an ear swab. This examination can establish the real problem with the dog's ears. Further confirmation can be sought with an otoscope to check the auditory passageway and the tympanic membrane.

In certain conditions, a complete flushing out of the debris is required. This is done with the use of antibiotic cleaners.

Antibiotic dog ear cleaners are required in cases where your veterinarian wants to either examine the ears thoroughly or flush out all the debris and bacteria that is causing infections.

Apart from flushing out wax and other substances, antibiotic cleaners are used for alkalizing and inhibiting bacterial growth. Bacterial otitis (inflammation of the ear) is a common occurrence in dogs. With medication, the bacteria undergo genetic mutations and adapt quickly. This requires periodic checks so that the adaptations can be monitored, and the most effective medication can be prescribed.

There are antibiotic ear cleaners that are a mix of vinegar, water, and drops of antibiotic solution. Dedicated antibiotic ear cleaners like Ethylene diamine tetra acetic acid tris (EDTA tris) are being used extensively for controlling bacterial infections and inflammations even though they are not permitted for veterinarian use.

It is important to note that chronic ear infections usually end up in the rupturing of the tympanic membrane. Care should be taken with your dog's ears to avoid antibiotic cleaners in such conditions since they can prove to be harmful.

Ear Mites

Ear mites are external parasites that can infect dogs, cats and in some cases, humans.

Otodectes cynotis is the most common mite that can infect pets and can cause a condition called otodectic mange - a persistent and contagious disease of the skin that causes inflammation, itching and loss of hair in dogs, cats, and other carnivores.

The otodectes cynotis mite can live its complete life cycle in the ear of a dog, or on the skin at times, as it feeds on the epidural wastes of the host. These mites can be large enough to be seen by the naked eye, and they are almost always easily visible under the magnifying glass. To examine and assess whether your dog has ear mites, scrape some wax from the ear and examine it closely.

It takes about 3 weeks for a mite egg to develop into an adult. Adult mites are very mobile and can be fairly contagious. They can travel from one pet to another and back again. The presence of mites in dogs can be determined by certain symptoms that an infected dog is likely to show.

These symptoms include excessive shaking of the head, itching and the presence of a blackish waxy messy substance in the ear canals.

Some dogs scratch at their ears and rub their face to such an extent that they cause bleeding that can lead to painful sores.

Dog mites also cause dark brown or black debris to accumulate in the ears. Secondary infection can follow an ear mite infection since the probability of contacting a bacteria or yeast infection increases. The presence of such infections also complicates the process of diagnosis.

If you are an informed person and do diagnose the likely presence of ear mites in your dog, don't use over the counter products. At times, these products can actually increase the discomfort of your pet. Incorrect administration of medicines can also lead to further complications.

Since there are various classifications of ear infections that a dog can suffer from, it is best to have your dog examined by a veterinarian. You should also evaluate home remedies for dog ear mites and provide comfort for your dog before the infection worsens.

Flatulence

[Dog flatulence](#) can be very embarrassing for you and very uncomfortable for your dog. After all, you can only blame the dog once or twice, even if it really is him!

Dog flatulence is usually caused by undigested food in the stomach. Many dogs gulp down their food along with large amounts of air that results in him being bloated and feeling unwell. A good high quality diet can be the simple answer to dog flatulence, with plenty of raw food. Cut out the titbits that you feed your dog as he may be incapable of digesting them properly and this can lead to flatulence.

Chocolate is particularly poisonous to dogs and any food high in sugar should also be avoided.

Cook food in stainless-steel pans, not aluminum or copper pans.

Regular exercise will help to keep your pet healthy and fit and can often help with [flatulence problems](#).

Hookworms

Hookworms are parasites that live in the small intestines of mammals. It is also the most common of the intestinal parasites that infest dogs. There are different types of hookworms that can infest dogs and cats.

A.caninum can infect a dog.

Uncinaria stenocephala can infect both dogs and cats.

A.braziliense and *A. tubaeforme* species of the hookworm infect only cats.

Hookworms are smaller than other intestinal parasites like dog tapeworms and roundworms. Their effect on the host's body is also different from other parasitical worms. Worms in dogs are usually excreted and are visible in stools, but hookworms are so small that they cannot be seen with the naked eye. In most cases, even a microscopic examination is unable to reveal their presence.

Hookworms are also different from other worms in the manner in which they cause diseases. The other kinds of worms mechanically obstruct the intestinal passage and migrate through tissues, but hookworms cling to the intestinal walls and suck the host's blood.

Dogs can get infested with hookworms in many ways. Hookworms lay eggs in the intestines of an infested animal. The eggs are then excreted through stools. Once the eggs hatch, the larvae can migrate through water and vegetation and enter a dog's body through various routes.

Infestation can occur when a dog consumes larvae from infested water or soil or eats another animal like a rodent that is already infected. Some larvae can directly penetrate the dog's skin. Other means of infestation can be linked to the birth process.

Puppies can get infested with hookworms while in the uterus or when nursing if their mother is already infested.

It takes about five to seven weeks for an adult hookworm to mature, mate and lay eggs. For this reason, diagnosing infestation at an early stage is difficult. It is most likely that symptoms of hookworms in dogs will surface before you can actually detect any worms in the dog's feces. Once infested, hookworms produce a somewhat different set of symptoms as compared to other intestinal parasites.

These are some of the symptoms:

Weight loss to the extent of emaciation

Dark stools that appear like tar

Dry and dull coat

Pale gums

Restricted growth in younger dogs

Hookworms are voracious blood suckers and can cause severe anemia. Hookworms also damage the mucus-secreting membrane that lines the body cavity.

Hookworm infestation is potentially fatal.

Roundworms

Roundworms have evolved in such a manner that they can thrive in almost any environment. They can be found in freshwater, sea water and even terrestrial environments. There are nearly 20,000 species of roundworms, out of which 15,000 are parasitic. They are also the most prevalent of the worms compared to all other types of worms in dogs.

Many dogs are born with roundworms. These are generally passed to them by their mothers through the uterus or through the mammary glands. A mother can transmit larvae that are lying dormant in her tissues or organs to the fetuses she is carrying. She can also transmit the larvae while nursing since the larvae can enter the mammary glands and be ingested by the puppies.

There are, however, other ways in which roundworms can enter the body of a dog. The most common among them is by ingestion. Dogs can consume roundworm eggs or larvae-infected feces since many dogs do have a tendency towards coprophagy (eating feces). They can also ingest larvae by eating other infected animals like rodents.

Roundworms have a complicated system of migration in the body. The migration process depends upon the age of the dog. In adult dogs, roundworm eggs hatch inside the body and the larvae migrates to the respiratory system or other parts of the body.

They can remain dormant inside an organ and can resurface years later.

In younger dogs, the larvae generally migrate to the respiratory system. These are then coughed up as vomit. In most cases, the dogs eat the vomit and the larvae enter the stomach. Upon maturing in the intestines, the adult worms produce eggs that are excreted in the stool, and the cycle continues.

All [parasites](#) feed off the host. Unlike dog tapeworms that absorb food through their skin, roundworms have separate orifices for ingestion and excretion. Roundworms intake whatever they can from what the dog eats, depriving the host dog of the nourishment that is necessary for its growth and health.

Diagnosing the prevalence of roundworms is relatively easy. A close examination of the stools should reveal if your dog is infected with roundworm since the whole worm can be seen in the stool. The round spaghetti-like shape is also easy to decipher. It is possible that you observe symptoms of worms in dogs even when there is no physical evidence of the presence of roundworms in the stools. In such cases, a microscopic evaluation of the dog's stool becomes essential to determine if roundworm eggs are present.

Many times you may actually see some common feline parasites in dog stools. This can happen if your dog has ingested infected cat feces.

Although roundworms have a role to play in the overall ecosystem, they can lead to unmanageable conditions inside a dog's body. Early detection can prove to be very beneficial and can help you get rid of the menace sooner.

Treatment is of prime importance, and any treatment of worms in dogs should be repeated over time to effectively kill all live and dormant larvae.

Immunity and Liver

Dog seizures are due to abnormal electrical responses within the brain, that can result in a loss of consciousness and certain physical signs that can be associated with the seizure.

Most dog seizures usually last between 30 seconds to 2 to 3 minutes. Some dogs have been known to have one seizure all their lives, while others develop serious repeated dog seizures.

Seizures are an exhausting experience and most dogs will want to sleep afterwards so allow them a place to be quiet on their own.

Seizures in dogs can occur as a reaction to medication, allergies, toxins, distemper, or can be due to canine epilepsy. Some other common causes are environmental toxins, from poisons to rotting garbage and plants.

If your dog is having a seizure, try to keep calm and make a note of all the details so that you may accurately describe it to your veterinarian. This will help him to diagnose the problem more easily.

Types of dog seizures include:

Generalized Seizure: Tonic-clonic

The dog may fall and lose consciousness extending its legs rigidly, respiration may stop. This lasts around 10-30 seconds and is known as the tonic phase.

As the clonic stage begins, the dog may lose control of the bladder and bowels. Pupils become dilated and limbs begin a paddling motion. Chewing and salivation may also occur.

Partial Seizures

Partial seizures are usually associated with secondary

epilepsy. Movements are restricted to one area of the body, such as muscle jerking, movement of one limb, turning the head or facial twitches.

Complex Partial Seizures

Complex partial seizures are usually associated with secondary epilepsy. They involve abnormal behaviours such as aggression, chewing, loud barking or howling, hysterical running, cowering or hiding. Diarrhoea, vomiting, salivation and excessive thirst or appetite, and back biting are also signs.

The dog seems oblivious to his surroundings but usually does not lose consciousness. This type of seizure in dogs may last minutes or hours and can be followed by a generalized seizure.

Cluster Seizures

Multiple seizures within a short period of time with only brief periods of consciousness in between. It can be difficult to distinguish between cluster seizures and status epilepticus but both should be treated as an emergency and a vet called immediately.

Status epilepticus

Seizures In dogs are very unlikely to be fatal, but they do

put tremendous stress on the heart, lungs and circulation and when seizures occur in clusters, dogs are prone to developing status epilepticus, a condition characterized by continuous, uncontrollable seizure activity.

Status epilepticus is a neurological emergency which requires immediate intervention by a vet.

It's important to know that dogs do not swallow their tongues during seizures, so owners should never put their hands near a dog's mouth or they can be badly bitten.

Epilepsy

[Epilepsy](#) is the most common cause of seizures in the dog and is caused by abnormal and repetitive electrical activity in the brain neurons.

Epilepsy is not necessarily a long-term medical problem, although it is a challenging condition, but most affected animals can live a normal life with anti-epileptic drugs.

Types of epilepsy in dogs

Generalized seizures are usually associated with primary epilepsy. Primary, or idiopathic, epilepsy, there is no known cause.

Partial seizures are usually associated with secondary epilepsy. Secondary epilepsy refers to seizures for which a cause can be determined, and there are many .

Complex partial seizures are usually associated with secondary epilepsy.

Treating Seizures and epilepsy in Dogs

Early diagnosis and treatment are important in preventing the regularity of future seizures. Generally, conventional medicine for epilepsy is not prescribed unless the dog has at least one seizure per month, as the main aim of the treatment is to reduce, rather than to eliminate the frequency of seizures.

If seizure control does prove to be necessary the two most common medications used to treat seizures in dogs are Phenobarbital and Potassium Bromide.

Many dogs live very normal lives despite epilepsy and seizures and some even participate in competition and serve as therapy dogs.
